All references to dollars (\$) are to United States dollars.

Details and percentages do not necessarily add up to the totals shown because of rounding.

A hyphen (-) indicates that the item is not applicable.

The tables are designed in such a way that they can be used as stand-alone sources of information.

The financial data in the tables on projects reflect the situation as at 31 December 2021. In early 2021, budget figures were adjusted to reflect exact income.

Total income 2018–2021 refers to funding received within that period. For projects financed by the United Nations Development Programme, total income equals total expenditures.

The classification of economies by development status is intended for statistical convenience and does not express a judgment about the stage reached by a particular country or an area in the development process. As of December 2021, the United Nations Statistics Division no longer maintains the categorization of developing and developed regions in the standard country or area codes for statistical use (M49 standard), but the categorization can continue to be applied. In the classification applied by UNCTAD, the Republic of Korea is part of the developed country group (as recorded at the sixty-eighth session of the Trade and Development Board of UNCTAD).<sup>1</sup>
